

Develop your singing skills with SOC Academy

Sheffield Oratorio Chorus offers members free or low cost opportunities to help develop and improve their singing skills. We call this development and education programme 'SOC Academy' and encourage all members to take advantage of this opportunity.

If you are not a SOC member you are also very welcome and you can sign up to attend Academy classes 1, 2 or 3 below for a small charge.

Courses are as follows:

1. Sight-singing

- Sight-singing exercises and examples
- Recognising scales, arpeggios and patterns
- Work on rhythms
- Memory and key awareness

2. Theory classes

- Focus on key-recognition, one of the most important aspects in sight-singing

3. Vocal technique classes

- Breathing and posture
- Using breath evenly and singing a good line
- Ascending and descending phrases / keeping pitch

- Additional support muscles
- Placing the sound throughout the range / keeping pitch
- Tongue flexibility, vowel matching and blending
- Breath release for crescendo and diminuendo
- Singing staccato, runs, and general vocal flexibility

Vocal Clinics (free, only available to members)

One to one individually tailored help with voice development including:

- Breathing techniques
- Vocal techniques and voice production/ range
- Diction
- Tips on pitch and blending
- Exploring changes in the voice
- Tips for the ageing voice

Academy classes are led by either SOC Musical Director Alan East or Vocal Coach Vivien Pike.

Vocal Clinics are conducted by our Vocal Coach and will be offered to individual members regularly.

Classes and clinics are not auditions. We audition new members when they join SOC, and hold auditions for smaller singing groups when necessary.
